ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to William C. White, doing business as Inter-Valley Transportation, has been suspended since September 20, 1961, for failure to maintain tariffs and a classification as required under the Public Utilities Code.<sup>1</sup> An investigation by the Commission staff discloses that no common carrier service has been performed by White since April 25, 1961. Moreover, White's reports of revenue for the first and second quarters of 1961 indicate that his operations have been limited to subhauling.

William C. White having failed to maintain the required tariffs and classification in effect and having abandoned highway common carrier operations under his certificate of public convenience and necessity and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure and abandonment constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the tariffs applicable to the services thereunder,

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<sup>1</sup>The certificate authorizes service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities between Fresno, on the one hand, and various San Joaquin Valley points, on the other.

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to William C. White, doing business as Inter-Valley Transportation, by Decision No. 58297 dated April 21, 1959, in Application No. 40164 is hereby revoked.

(2) C. R. Nickerson, Agent, and Interstate Freight Carriers Conference, Inc., Agent, are hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of William C. White, doing business as Inter-Valley Transportation, from their tariffs on file with this Commission, said cancellations to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.


(3) Powers of Attorney AF 1 No. 1, AF 1 No. 2 and AF 1 No. 3 in favor of Western Classification Committee, C. R. Nickerson and Interstate Freight Carriers Conference, Inc., respectively, issued by William C. White, doing business as Inter-Valley Transportation, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon William C. White or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Western Classification Committee, C. R. Nickerson and Interstate Freight Carriers Conference, Inc.


The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon William C. White or after the above mailing to William C. White, as the case may be, unless before such
