<u>opinion</u>

By this petition the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks increases in certain of the zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 that apply for for-hire transportation of rock, sand, gravel and decomposed granite by dump truck equipment between points in Southern California. In general, the rates which are involved are those that apply for hauls of about 10 miles or less in the areas described below. 1 The present rates for said

Los Angeles County, except the Antelope Valley portion thereof; Orange County; San Bernardino County; Riverside County; San Diego County, except the southern portion thereof; and Ventura County.

b. The increases to be made in rates in excess of 64 cents per ton be graduated so that no increases be made in present rates of 80 cents per ton, and that no increased rates be established that would be in excess of 80 cents per ton.

Public hearings on the petition were held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on August 22, 23, September 13, 14, 26, October 10, 11, 31 and November 1, 1960. Evidence in support of the proposals was presented by petitioner through its general manager and various carrier witnesses. Evidence in opposition to the proposals was presented by the Southern California Rock Products Association through representatives of rock products producers and carriers. A representative of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., and members of the Commission's staff also participated in the development of the record. The matter was taken under submission for decision with the filing of briefs on December 23, 1960.

Subsequently, on April 11, 1961, the submission was set aside by order of the Commission, and the matter was reopened for further hearings thereon. Said hearings were held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on July 12, 13, 17, and September 13, 1961. Additional evidence was presented by petitioner and by the Southern California Rock Products Association. The further hearings were closed with oral argument on the last-named date, when the matter was resubmitted.

The zone rates which are in issue herein have been in effect at their present level for more than seven years. As grounds for its proposals that certain of these rates should now be increased, petitioner states that the carriers' costs of operation have increased substantially during the 7-year interval, and that the impact of the cost increases has been felt particularly by those carriers whose operations are conducted by means of 3-axle dump truck equipment and whose hauls of rock products are principally for distances of 10 miles or less. Although other dump truck carriers whose operations are conducted by larger equipment have likewise experienced increases in their operating costs, the effect thereof assertedly has been alleviated in part by highway improvements that permit operating economies which are realized mainly in hauls for distances in excess of 10 miles.

The rate increases which petitioner seeks are those which, in the judgment of petitioner's officers and directors, are needed as an interim measure to enable the carriers to meet the increases in operating costs pending further rate adjustments to be made upon the completion of studies in other phases of this general proceeding which are directed toward a general revision of the minimum rates for for-hire transportation by dump truck equipment (Order Setting Hearing, dated March 24, 1959, and Petition No. 48, Case No. 5437).

The evidence which petitioner introduced in support of the sought rate increases was confined mainly to a showing by petitioner's manager of costs applicable to the operation of 3-axle dump truck equipment. In addition petitioner submitted evidence through several carrier witnesses to show that the transportation

which operators of 3-axle equipment are called upon to provide involves hauls for relatively short distances or to locations which vare not readily accessible to larger equipment, and that for such hauls the time required per delivery has not been materially affected by highway improvements over the past 15 years.

In the matter of costs petitioner's manager submitted estimates to the effect that the costs of transporting rock products in 3-axle dump truck equipment during the year 1960 amounted to \$9.45 per hour. These estimates were presented as a product of informed judgment of the manager, based on his close association with virtually all phases of for-hire dump truck transportation over the past 20 years. The manager testified, furthermore, that since the establishment of the level of the zone rates in issue herein the basic wage rate for drivers of 3-axle dump trucks has increased almost \$1.00 per hour -- from \$1.99 per hour in 1954 to \$2.96 per hour in 1960. As another indication of the present level of the costs of service by 3-axle dump trucks, the manager pointed to the fact that as of May 15, 1960, the Commission established a rate of \$8.17 per hour as a reasonable minimum rate for said service under the costs then in effect. He compared this rate with amounts of \$6.00 to \$6.25 which, he said, are the hourly revenues that carriers attain in the operation of 3-axle dump truck

The rate of \$8.17 per hour has since been increased to \$8.41 per hour (Decision No. 62031, dated May 22, 1961). Said rates are those for dump truck equipment of cubical capacities of more than 8 but not more than 9 cubic yards.

equipment under present zone rates.3

The Southern California Rock Products Association, protestant in this matter, took sharp issue with petitioner's showing, contending that it does not provide a basis for increases in the mates as sought. Protestant particularly excepted to the showing to the extent that it rests on the statement of costs which was presented as a product of informed judgment of petitioner's manager. Protestant's position in this respect is that for the purposes for which the cost statement was presented, the statement is not competent evidence and should not be treated as such. Protestant also objected to increases in the rates for 10 miles or less on the basis of the costs of operating 3-axle dump truck equipment. Evidence was introduced by protestant to show that the present rates permit profitable operation of larger equipment in the transportation of rock products for distances of less than 10 miles, and that a substantial portion of the transportation involved is performed by the larger equipment. Protestant also submitted evidence to show that highway improvements have resulted in reductions in delivery times, and that the reductions, as reflected in the carriers' operating costs, have tended to affect cost increases that the carriers may have experienced otherwise. Protestant moved for

Petitioner's manager also submitted data to show hourly costs of 3-axle dump truck operations as developed from responses to questionnaires sent to a number of operators of such vehicles. These data were excluded upon protestant's objection that no opportunity was afforded to test by cross-examination the reliability of the information set forth in the responses. Such and other infirmities of showings developed by the questionnaire method have been pointed out on occasion in decisions of the Commission heretofore. See, for example, Decision No. 47074, dated April 29, 1952, in Case No. 4808, Re Rates of Carriers of Property.

drivers have been increased by approximately \$1.00 per hour. As related to the costs upon which the rates were established, the resultant costs are in excess of the rates. Insofar as those carriers whose operations are conducted by 3-axle dump trucks are concerned, it appears that said carriers have not been able to offset the cost increases by improvements in operating circumstances otherwise. To deny increases in the rates for the transportation that is performed principally by means of the 3-axle vehicles would deprive the carriers that operate said vehicles of revenues reasonably necessary to the maintenance of their services. Although studies are in progress towards a general revision of the zone rates, that fact of itself is not sufficient justification for withholding increases in rates that are unreasonably low. The rate increases which are hereinafter prescribed will be in the nature of interim adjustments pending completion of the aforesaid studies and decision thereon.

In basing its showing in this matter on costs applicable to the operations of carriers utilizing 3-axle dump truck equipment, petitioner assumes that the revenue needs of such carriers should be controlling with respect to transportation for distances of 10 miles or less. This assumption conforms to the basis upon which the zone rates were constructed. It is evident from protestant's showing, however, that the larger dump truck vehicles have become a material factor in the transportation of rock products for the distances involved and can operate effectively for distances as short as 4 to 5 miles. The rate adjustments which are prescribed herein will take this circumstance into consideration.

From a standpoint of costs we find that the increases in rates to be established should be on the increases in labor costs which the record shows have occurred since the establishment of the zone rates in issue. Such rate increases are less than those which petitioner seeks, and less than those which petitioner's cost showing, as represented by the judgment figures of petitioner's manager, would seem to require. The showing in this respect, resting essentially upon the judgment of petitioner's manager, and lacking supporting evidence by which the validity of his cost conclusions might be evaluated, does not constitute an acceptable basis for the prescription of increases in the minimum rates.

Where petitioner is seeking increases in the present zone rates of less than 80 cents per ton, the increases will be limited to the rates of less than 70 cents per ton. Where petitioner seeks

the establishment of rates no lower than 35 cents a ton, the minimum rate to be established in this respect will be 30 cents a ton. In other respects the increases will be decreasingly graduated from about 20 percent in the rates for very short hauls until the upper limit of 70 cents per ton is reached.⁵

Upon consideration of the facts and circumstances of record, the Commission finds as a fact that the granting of the petition in this matter for the establishment of increased zone rates has been shown justified to the extent indicated above. The Commission further finds that the rates which would be so established, and which are prescribed by the order which follows, are, and will be, just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation that would be subject thereto.

ORDER

Based on the evidence of record and on the findings and conclusions in the preceding opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7

(Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 3, 1962, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix "B" also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof by this reference.

The increased rates to be established are set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto.

C. 5437, Pet. 64 - SW In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that except as is otherwise provided herein the above-numbered petition in this matter be, and it hereby is, denied. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the motion of Southern California Rock Products Association for dismissal of the abovenumbered petition in this matter be, and it hereby is, denied.
