## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application  
of the City of Oakland, a municipal  
corporation, to construct a public  
street extending northwesterly from  
69th Avenue southwesterly of Hawley  
Street in said City, across a joint  
spur railroad track of the Southern  
Pacific Company and The Western  
Pacific Railroad Company. }

O R D E R

The City of Oakland is authorized to construct an unnamed public street at grade across a joint spur track of Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Hawley Street, Oakland, Alameda County, at the location and substantially as described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 4-11.97-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material (General Order No. 75-B). Upon completion of Crossing No. 4-11.97-C, Crossing No. 4-12.0-C, located at the intersection of 69th Avenue and Hawley Street, shall be abolished and closed by the responsible railroad.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant desires to begin construction of a housing project of the City of Oakland Housing Authority and has requested immediate authorization. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
