IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Ordering paragraph No. 2(b) of Decision No. 62694, dated October 17, 1961, in this proceeding be, and it is, amended to read as follows:




2. Appendix A to said Decision No. 62694 be, and it is, amended by substituting First Revised Page 1, hereto attached, in place and stead of Original Page 1.
