ORDER ON PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 62645, dated October 10, 1961, in this proceeding, the Commission, among other things, authorized D. S. Adams, D. Q. Adams, D. Q. Adams, Jr., W. W. Adams, W. W. Adams, Jr., Elizabeth Adams McClure and Margaret Adams Dallam, doing business as Adams, Schwab & Adams Warehouse Company, to transfer their public utility warehouse rights, properties and operations to D. S. Adams, D. Q. Adams, W. W. Adams, W. W. Adams, Jr., W. O. Adams, Elizabeth Adams McClure, Margaret Adams Dallam, Nancy Adams Bloom and Elizabeth Adams Peabody.

In their petition for modification filed on December 7, 1961, the applicants state that in connection with such transaction D. Q. Adams, Jr., proposes to transfer his interest to D. S. Adams, D. Q. Adams, W. O. Adams, Nancy Adams Bloom and Elizabeth Adams Peabody and, upon the request of the title company, they now seek specified authorization for such transfer.

The Commission has considered this petition for modification and finds and concludes that the proposed additional transfer is not adverse to the public interest, that a public hearing is not necessary, and that the petition should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that -

1. In addition to the authority granted by Decision No. 62645, dated October 10, 1961, D. Q. Adams, Jr., may transfer his interest in the public utility warehouse rights, properties and operations referred to in this proceeding to D. S. Adams, D. Q. Adams, W. O. Adams, Nancy Adams Bloom and Elizabeth Adams Peabody, on or before March 31, 1962.

2. The expiration date for the authority granted by said Decision No. 62645 be, and it hereby is, extended to March 31, 1962.

3. Said Decision No. 62645 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.

4. This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
