SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission, by Decision No. 62704, issued October 17, 1961, in the above-entitled and numbered consolidated proceedings, directed five highway carriers, including West Trucking Service, Inc., respondents herein, to file with the Commission, within fifteen days after the effective date of said order, their annual reports for the year ended December 31, 1959. The order further directed that if any such annual reports were not filed within said period, then, "upon the filing of a certificate by the Secretary that such annual report has not been filed within the time prescribed, all operating rights then held by such respondent or respondents and tariffs applicable in connection therewith will be suspended by supplemental orders herein".

Certified copies of Decision No. 62704 were duly served on each of the five carriers. All, with the exception of West Trucking Service, Inc., have filed their annual reports for the year 1959.

On December 11, 1961, the Secretary filed with the Commission his certificate that no annual report of West Trucking Service, Inc., for the year ended December 31, 1959, had been received by the Commission within the period prescribed by Decision No. 62704 nor at any subsequent time. The Commission's records also reveal that on February 7, 1961, Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 12-1004, issued to said carrier on July 24, 1947, was revoked for failure to maintain on deposit required liability insurance and that said permit has not since been reinstated.

We find, under the foregoing circumstances, that no useful purpose would be served by further proceedings herein and conclude, accordingly, that the investigation should be discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 6982 and Case No. 6983 are, and each of said investigation proceedings is, hereby discontinued.
