ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this petition, California Trucking Associations, Inc., seeks an amendment to Distance Table No. 4 to establish constructive mileage between Bodega Bay and Bodega Bay Atomic Park, both points in Sonoma County.

Petitioner alleges that the development of commercial nuclearfueled power generating facilities at the latter location by the

Pacific Gas and Electric Company will create the necessity for a

basis for determining reasonable and suitable constructive mileages
in connection therewith; that such mileages determined under the

current provisions of Distance Table No. 4 are unreasonable and unsuitable; and that distance rates determined therefrom are unreasonable and insufficient.

An investigation was undertaken and report thereof made by the Commission's Transportation Division engineering staff to determine constructive mileages to and from the location in question.

The staff report shows that a county road extends from Bodega Bay toward the proposed plant site for a distance of approximately two miles and there terminates. The report indicates that condemnation proceedings to acquire a right-of-way between the latter point and the plant site have been instituted by Pacific Gas and Electric

Company. The engineer's report states that the staff is unable to ascertain, by formula factors, or otherwise, the constructive mileage on a portion of a road which does not exist. The staff report is received in evidence in this proceeding as Exhibit No. 1-1.

Official notice is taken of Application No. 43808, filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company with this Commission October 4, 1961, seeking authority to construct, install, operate and maintain nuclear facilities at Bodega Bay Atomic Park. The application states, among other things, that on or about May 1, 1962, the Company intends to make application to the Atomic Energy Commission for a license to construct and operate such facilities. Public hearings are to be scheduled in this matter.

Associations, Inc., for the establishment of constructive mileage between Bodega Bay and a plant site designated as Bodega Bay Atomic Park was filed prematurely. Inasmuch as no basis currently appears on which the sought constructive mileage may be established, the petition will be dismissed without prejudice to the filing of another petition if, and when, the actual highway route is established.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 1 in Case
No. 7024 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
