SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, Alco Transportation Co. was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities. The following commodity exclusion is included in the certificate:

"Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment."

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated July 7, 1961, the carrier informed the Commission that it would have no objection to the revision of its certificate to make the commodity exclusion consistent with the application of the temperature control charges. The certificate will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Alco Transportation Co. by Decision No. 60986, dated November 1, 1960, in Application No. 42257, is hereby amended by substituting First Revised Page 2 in place and stead of Original Page 2.
- (2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, Alco Transportation Co. shall amend its tariff on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
