SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, Consolidated Freightways Corporation of Delaware acquired certificates of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities with certain exceptions.

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated October 24, 1961, the carrier informed the Commission that it would have no objection to the Commission amending its certificates to exclude the transportation of commodities subject to the application of the temperature control charges. The certificates will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificates of public convenience and necessity granted in Ordering Paragraph (1)(f) of Decision No. 43003, dated June 14, 1949, as amended in Application No. 27226, Decision No. 30591, dated February 7, 1938, in Application No. 21523, and Decision No. 50864, dated December 14, 1954, in Application No. 35007, all as acquired by Consolidated Freightways Corporation of Delaware by Decision No. 58545, dated June 8, 1959, as amended, in Application No. 41163, are hereby further amended

by adding the following commodity exclusion to the exceptions to general commodities:

Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration.


(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, Consolidated Freightways Corporation of Delaware shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.




