SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, Millage Produce, Inc., acquired certificates of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities with certain exceptions.

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated June 21, 1961, the carrier requested that the Commission amend its certificates to exclude the transportation of commodities subject to the application of the temperature control charges. The certificates will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificates of public convenience and nocessity granted by Decision No. 44229 dated May 23, 1950, in Application No. 30879, Decision No. 47804 dated October 7, 1952, as amended, and Decision No. 48105 dated Decembor 22, 1952, in Application

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No. 33528, as acquired by Millage Produce, Inc., by Decision No. 59804 dated March 22, 1960, in Application No. 41898; are hereby amended by adding the following commodity exclusion to the exceptions to general commodities:

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, Millage Produce, Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
