SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, Milne Truck Lines, Inc., acquired a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of property with certain exceptions.

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."


By letter dated August 17, 1961, the carrier requested that the Commission amend its certificates to exclude the transportation of commodities subject to the application of the temperature control charges. The certificate will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Lines, Inc., by Decision No. 54876 dated April 22, 1957, as amended, in Application No. 38901, is hereby further amended by adding the following commodity exclusion:

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, Milne Truck Lines, Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
