SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, A. R. Pearson Truck Co., Inc., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities. The following commodity exclusion is included in the certificate:

"Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment."

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated June 16, 1961, the carrier informed the Commission that it would have no objection to the revision of its certificate to make the commodity exclusion consistent with the application of the temperature control charges. The certificate will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.


IT IS ORDERED that:


(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to A. R. Pearson Truck Co., Inc., by Decision No. 55255, dated July 9, 1957, as amended, in Application No. 36197, is hereby further amended by substituting Second Revised Page 1 in place and stead of First Revised Page 1.


(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, A. R. Pearson Truck Co., Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
