SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, C. J. and C. E. Fortier, currently doing business as Reedley-Selma-Kingsburg Truck Lines, acquired certificates of public convenience and necessity and prescriptive rights authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of freight. There are no commodity exclusions included in the certificates.

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated August 17, 1961, the carrier requested that the Commission amend their certificates to exclude the transportation of commodities subject to the application of the temperature control charges. The certificates and prescriptive rights will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificates of public convenience and necessity and prescriptive operative rights acquired by C. J. and C. E.

Fortier by Decision No. 31838 dated March 20, 1939, in Application No. 22609, as amended, are further amended by adding the following commodity exclusion:


"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, C. J. and C. E. Fortier shall amend their tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.


