SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, Transcon Lines acquired certificates of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities with certain exceptions.

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated June 19, 1961, the carrier informed the Commission that it would have no objection to the Commission amending its certificates to exclude the transportation of commodities subject to the application of the temperature control charges. The certificates will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificates of public convenience and necessity granted to Savage Transportation Co., Inc., by Decision No. 43003, dated June 14, 1949, in Application No. 23877, and Decision No. 51286 dated April 5, 1955, in Application No. 34537,

as amended and as acquired by Transcon Lines by Decision No. 53154 dated May 28, 1956, in Application No. 37038, are hereby further amended by adding the following commodity exclusion to. the exceptions to general commodities:

> "Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, Transcon Lines shall amend its tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
