SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the decision hereinafter identified, William B. Walton, doing business as Walton Drayage & Warehouse Co., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier of general commodities. The following commodity exclusion is included in the certificate:

"Commodities requiring mechanically refrigerated equipment."

Under Decision No. 61177, dated December 13, 1960, in Case No. 5432, temperature control charges were established on

"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."

By letter dated June 19, 1961, the carrier informed the Commission that he would have no objection to the revision of his certificate to make the commodity exclusion consistent with the application of the temperature control charges. The certificate will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:


(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to William B. Walton, doing business as Walton Drayage & Warehouse Co., by Decision No. 50986, dated January 18, 1955, in Application No. 35171, is hereby amended by substituting for the commodity exclusion "Commodities requiring mechanically refrigerated equipment" the following commodity exclusion:


"Commodities requiring protection from heat by the use of ice (either water or solidified carbon dioxide) or by mechanical refrigeration."


(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, William B. Walton shall amend his tariffs on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.


