OPINION AND ORDER

By Petition for Modification No. 18, California Moving & Storage Association, Inc., seeks to modify the description of Metropolitan Sacramento Area, which is set forth in Item No. 360 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A. The proposed change results in an enlargement of the present Metropolitan Sacramento Area and specifically includes the following additional points: Antelope, Citrus Heights, Elverta, Fair Oaks, Folsom, Freeport and Orangevale.

Petitioner alleges that the present description has been in effect for more than seven years despite the fact that the City of Sacramento and its environs have substantially increased from a population standpoint; that new communities have come into being both within the presently described area and within that herein proposed; and that the proposed description will give realistic effect to the development of Metropolitan Sacramento and will accord to the enlarged area a reduction in rates.

The petition shows that copies thereof were served on all known interested parties. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the modification in the minimum rates as proposed is reasonable and that the resulting minimum rates and charges will be just,

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reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges for the transportation of used household goods and other property. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A will be revised accordingly. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The petition will be granted.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 44919, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 24, 1962, Second Revised Page 23 and First Revised Page 23-E, which revised pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- (2) In all other respects said Decision No. 44919, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
