O P I N I O N

A request was filed January 11, 1961, that applicant's Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 19-52789, issued October 5, 1959, be amended to authorize the transportation of General Commodities as they are set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, except bulk petroleum products, commodities in dump trucks, livestock, used household goods, cement products and fresh produce.

At present applicant's operating authority is limited to the statewide transportation of alcoholic beverages, canned goods, groceries, empty glass bottles, and sugar.

Public hearing was held before Examiner Martin J. Porter at Los Angeles on June 28, 1961, on which date the matter was submitted. ✓

The president of applicant company testified that the financial condition of the company is better than it was at the time of the filing of the application for the limited permit the company now holds.

The applicant now has the opportunity of obtaining additional business in lines that are not now permitted under the present permit.

Upon consideration of the evidence the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

1. Applicant possesses the financial responsibility to perform the operations proposed.

O R D E R





Public hearing having been held and based upon the evidence therein adduced,

IT IS ORDERED that Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 19- 52789 is amended to authorize the transportation of General Commodities within the scope of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, except bulk petroleum products, commodities in dump trucks, livestock, used household goods, cement products and fresh produce.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission shall cause the records to be changed to reflect the authority granted.
