ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to H. H. Stacey has been suspended since May 7, 1960, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance.<sup>1</sup> The insurance was subsequently reinstated on January 1, 1961, and was again canceled February 27, 1961. Furthermore, the carrier does not have on file or in effect tariffs to cover his certificate. Also the carrier has not paid his fees or filed reports for the second and third quarters of 1961.

H. H. Stacey having failed to file quarterly reports and pay Transportation Rate Fund fees, having failed to have on file evidence of liability insurance, having failed to maintain tariffs in effect, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted H. H. Stacey by Decision No. 52486, dated January 16, 1956, in Application No. 36193, is hereby revoked.






The certificate authorizes the transportation of oranges, grapefruit, agricultural insecticides and paper between Los Angeles, Wilmington, San Pedro and Long Beach, on the one hand, and Redlands, on the other hand.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon H. H. Stacey or after the above mailing to H. H. Stacey, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, or requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
