Application of THE COUNTY OF VENTURA
to construct a street crossing over
the Southern Pacific Railroad (Coast
Route) north of the town of Simi in
the County of Ventura.

O R D E R

County of Ventura is authorized to reconstruct First Street (Crossing No. E-433.3) at grade across Southern Pacific Company's Coast Route in the town of Simi, Ventura County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

In order that the improvements herein authorized shall be constructed as soon as possible the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
