SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

California Motor Transport Co. of the West, a corporation, operates as a highway common carrier between points in the Los Angeles Basin Territory, the San Diego Territory, the San Francisco Territory, Redding and certain intermediate and off-route points. On January 8, 1962, it filed its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to California Motor Transport Co. Accordingly, its certificates will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be ordered to amend its tariffs by filing an appropriate adoption notice. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:


(1) Decision No. 62434, dated August 22, 1961, in Application No. 43621, is hereby amended by substituting "California Motor Transport Co." in place and stead of "California Motor Transport Co. of the West."


(2) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations


governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that California Motor Transport Co. of the West has withdrawn or canceled and California Motor Transport Co. has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
