## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California,  
 Department of Public Works, for an order  
 authorizing construction of a crossing  
 at separated grades whereby State Route  
 IV-CC-75-E, Cnd,H will be carried over  
 the track of the Southern Pacific Com-  
 pany, in Contra Costa County, referred  
 to as "Concord Overhead".

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to construct State Route 75 (Sign Route 24) at separated grades over the track of the San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company, near Concord, Contra Costa County, at the location as shown by map Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application and substantially as set forth in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BC-42.2-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, applicant is authorized to create impaired vertical clearances of 21' 0" above top of rail and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such temporary impaired clearance conditions provided it issue appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the impaired clearance conditions and forbidding trainmen to ride on tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
