County of San Joaquin is hereby authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Jack Tone Road at grade with a track of Tidewater Southern Railway Company, Crossing No. 75-9.2 near Turner, San Joaquin County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty fect and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Company shall be ar maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

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authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
