OPINION

Pacific Power & Light Company, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the Town of Dorris, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of an electric distribution and transmission system upon the streets of said town.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the Town of Dorris in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the town equivalent to 2 percent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 percent of the gross annual receipts from sales of electricity within the limits of the Town of Dorris under said franchise.

The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been \$150, which amount does not include costs incident to this application.

Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the Town of Dorris, by Ordinance No. 141, adopted December 4, 1961.
