O P I N I O N

Pacific Power & Light Company, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the Town of Dorris, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of an electric distribution and transmission system upon the streets of said town.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the Town of Dorris in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the town equivalent to 2 percent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 percent of the gross annual receipts from sales of electricity within the limits of the Town of Dorris under said franchise.

The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been \$150, which amount does not include costs incident to this application.

Applicant or its predecessors have, for many years, served electricity in and about the Town of Dorris without competition. As of December 1961, it served 377 electric customers within the town. No protest to the granting of the application has been received. A public hearing is not necessary.

After consideration it is found as a fact that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by applicant of the right, privilege and franchise granted to applicant by Ordinance No. 141, of the Town of Dorris.

The certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted is subject to the following provisions of law:

1. That the Commission shall have no power to authorize the capitalization of the franchise involved herein or this certificate of public convenience and necessity or the right to own, operate or enjoy such franchise or certificate of public convenience and necessity in excess of the amount (exclusive of any tax or annual charge) actually paid to the State or to a political subdivision thereof as the consideration for the grant of such franchise, certificate of public convenience and necessity or right.
2. That the franchise involved herein shall never be given any value before any court or other public authority in any proceeding of any character in excess of the cost to the grantee of the necessary publication and any other sum paid by it to the municipality therefor at the time of the acquisition thereof.

O R D E R

The above-entitled application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is granted to Pacific Power & Light

Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the Town of Dorris, by Ordinance No. 141, adopted December 4, 1961.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
