FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 63305, dated February 20, 1962, in this proceeding, imposed a five day suspension of operations on the respondent. Respondent was given the alternative of paying a \$2,500 fine in lieu of such suspension and was given forty days from the date of personal service of the order to make the election. Respondent has communicated to the Commission in writing its election to accept the suspension rather than the fine. It also requests that the beginning date of said suspension be advanced to March 19, 1962. The request of respondent appears to be reasonable. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 63305, dated February 20, 1962 and made effective by personal service upon respondent on February 28, 1962, in this proceeding, be and it is amended to read as follows:

"1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 31-460 issued to Superior California Trucking Company, a corporation,

shall be suspended for five consecutive days starting at 12:01 a.m. on Monday, March 19, 1962."

2. As herein amended said Decision No. 63305 is continued in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
