O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade in, upon and across 3rd Street in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location and substantially as described in the application, to be identified as a portion of crossing No. D-5.6-C. Construction of said crossing at 3rd Street shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two additional Standard No.1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
