O R D E R

County of Monterey is hereby authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Wildhorse Canyon Road at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. E-167.2) near Welby, Monterey County, as described in the application and substantially in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet with grades of approach as shown in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
