Application of County of Monterey to
reconstruct grade Crossing No. EE-112.5,
Nashua County Road, across right of way
of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company
(Monterey Branch).

O R D E R

County of Monterey is hereby authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Nashua County Road at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. EE-112.5) near Neposet, Monterey County, as described in the application and in substantial accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by:

- (1) Two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75B), reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.
- (2) Two "Slow to 15" signs, one to be installed on each advanced warning signpost, to advise motorists of a vehicular speed limit requirement of 15 miles per hour at the crossing.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
