## QRDER

County of Kings is hereby authorized to relocate the crossing of Pickerell Avenue at grade with a track of The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company, Crossing No. 2V-1.1 near Corcoran, Kings County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Upox completion, Crossing No. 2V-1.18, about 185 feet easterly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
