## OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, as amended, authority is sought to cancel through routes and joint rates applicable between points on the lines of Hawkey Transportation, Inc., on the one hand, and points served by Southern Pacific Company, on the other hand. The rates in question are contained in Item 8510 of Tariff No. 255-G published by Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent.

The application states that no traffic has ever been transported under the joint rates proposed to be canceled; that the continuation of such joint rates results in an unnecessary tariff maintenance expense to applicants; and that the authority herein requested will not be adverse to the public interest.

The application shows that on or about November 30, 1961, and January 8, 1962, copies thereof were mailed to interested parties. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed cancellation of through routes and joint rates is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

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Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Hawkey Transportation, Inc., and Southern Pacific Company are hereby authorized to cancel, on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the through routes and joint rates as proposed in this application.

(2) The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within 120 days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
