## ORDER REVOKING DECISION

By petition filed February 28, 1962, Gordon B. Thrash, doing business as Gordon B. Thrash Trucking, requests that Decision No. 63094 dated January 9, 1962, in this proceeding, be rescinded. That decision amended the carrier's certificate of public convenience and necessity by excluding the transportation of commodities requiring temperature control service when subject to the application of temperature control charges. This amendment was made pursuant to a letter dated June 19, 1961, from the carrier stating that he had no objection to the Commission amending his certificate to exclude such transportation.

The carrier now states that he was not aware at that time that his tariff agent was publishing temperature control service rates, rules and regulations for his account. Moreover, applicant states that he did not realize that the certificate amendment would deprive the isolated areas of Dos Rios, Covelo and the Eel River Ranger Station of transportation service for packaged shipments of commodities requiring such protection, inasmuch as those areas are not served by any other highway common carrier. For these reasons,

the carrier requests cancellation of the aforesaid commodity exclusion and restoration of its operating rights as they were originally granted. Charges for temperature control service are currently named in tariffs to which the carrier is a participant.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 63094 dated January 9, 1962, is hereby revoked.
