OPINICN AND ORDER

M & R Services, a corporation, is authorized to operate as a public utility warehouseman in Pittsburg.¹ By this application it seeks to have its operative right revoked and its tariff canceled.

The application states that the warehouse storage space herein involved was leased from the U.S. Government; that on April 17, 1959, the General Services Administration declared the property surplus, canceled the lease, and sold it to divers other parties; and that since that date applicant has attempted to provide warehousing services at its marine terminal location which has proved impractical. The application further states that applicant has not provided warehouse service for anyone since October 31, 1961. It asserts that the financial requirements of applicant's marine terminal are such that it is not feasible to attempt to duplicate the warehouse operations formerly conducted.

Upon consideration of the allegations contained in the application, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed discontinuance and abandonment of the public utility warehouse operation as sought herein will not be adverse to the public interest. Applicant will be authorized to discontinue said operations and its tariff will be canceled. A public hearing is not necessary.

¹The warehouse operative right was determined by order of the Commission dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6845. Applicant also operates as a nonutility marine terminal handling bulk products on a contract basis with selected shippers.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. M & R Services, a corporation, is hereby authorized to discontinue operations as a public utility warehouseman at Pittsburg and the prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by M & R Services as determined by order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6845, is hereby revoked.

2. Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, of M & R Services, Inc., is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
