ORDER DENYING REHEARING

IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if, on or before the fortieth day after personal service of this order upon respondent, respondent has not paid the fine referred to in Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of Decision No. 63029, then Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 34-3258, Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 34-3697, City Carrier Permit No. 34-3738, and the Highway Common Carrier Certificate issued to Gus A. Melhaff shall be suspended for five consecutive days, starting at 12:01 a.m. on the second Monday following the fortieth day after such personal service.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause personal service of this order to be made upon Gus A. Melhaff.
