OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 61709, dated March 21, 1961, applicant was authorized to assess charges for the transportation of bakery goods in wheeled carriers on the net weight of the bakery goods exclusive of the weight of said wheeled carriers. <sup>1</sup> That authority is scheduled to expire April 22, 1962.

By this application, an extension of the current authority is sought for a further one-year period or such greater period as the Commission may order.

The application states that applicant's equipment is specially built for the transportation of bakery goods; that applicant can perform the service herein involved economically and at a profit; that the conditions which justified the current authority still exist substantially unchanged; and that the type and character of property and the specialized nature of the transportation service render it impracticable to assess charges on the gross weight of the wheeled carriers and their contents.

The application shows that on or about March 1, 1962, a copy thereof was mailed to the California Trucking Associations, Inc.

No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

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Item No. 70 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 provides that charges shall be assessed on the gross weight of the shipment and that no allowance shall be made for the weight of containers. Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and petroleum contract carrier permits.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted. However, as the conditions surrounding the transportation may change, the continuation of the current authority will be limited to one year unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

In view of the expiration date of the current authority, the order which follows will be made effective on April 22, 1962.


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Young's Commercial Transfer, Inc., is hereby authorized to assess charges on shipments of bakery goods in wheeled carriers on the net weight of the bakery goods exclusive of the weight of said wheeled carriers transported from the San Francisco Bay Area to points in northern and central California.

2. The authority granted herein shall, on and after April 22, 1962, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 61709 and shall expire with April 22, 1963.

This order shall become effective April 22, 1962.
