The additions and improvements contemplated by applicant consist of the following: Six steel grain storage bins 2. One rice drier unit 3. One receiving pit and tunnel and necessary elevators Conveyors and related equipment Necessary electrical wiring Concrete pavement surrounding the storage bin and drier installation Seed soaking equipment The estimated cost of providing the additions and improvements 1s stated to be \$225,357. - l -

- 2. Maxwell-Delevan Warehouse Corporation shall file with the Commission a report, or reports, as required by General Order No. 24-A, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.
- 3. The authority herein granted shall become effective when Maxwell-Delevan Warehouse Corporation has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$225.
