## ORDER REVOKING DECISION NO. 63083

By Decision No. 63083 dated January 9, 1962, in this proceeding, applicant's certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier was amended to exclude the transportation of commodities requiring temperature control service and subject to the application of temperature control charges. This amendment was made pursuant to a letter from the carrier dated June 27, 1961, stating that it had no objection to the revision of its certificate to make the commodity exclusion consistent with the application of the temperature control charges.

By letter dated March 26, 1962, the carrier has informed the Commission that upon further study it has concluded that the amendment made by Decision No. 63083 would be a distinct disadvantage upon its operations and that it wishes restoration of its rights as originally granted. Charges for temperature control service have been published in tariffs to which the carrier is a party.

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Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 63083, dated January 9, 1962, in Application No. 42134, is hereby revoked.
