ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct one temporary spur track at grade across Division Street and under the Central Freeway in the City and County of San Francisco at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. E-1.68-C and E-1.68-AC, respectively. Construction of said Crossing No. E-1.68-C shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the crew or other competent employee acting as a flagman.

The crossings authorized herein are temporary crossings to be used for a period not to exceed one year and at the end of such period the applicant shall remove the tracks shown in red on the map attached to the application in so far as they lie in Division Street and shall repair the roadway to conform to the remainder thereof.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant alleges that immediate construction is necessitated by street and sewer work of the City and County of San Francisco. Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
