Application of the CITY OF SANTA ANA
to establish a grade crossing of Susan
Street over and across a main track of
the Pacific Electric Railway Company.

Application No. 44299

O R D E R

The City of Santa Ana is hereby authorized to construct Susan Street at grade across a spur track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Santa Ana, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-33.79-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the improvement is urgently needed and requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
