O P I N I O N

This application alleges that in Application No. 43251 applicant's name was incorrectly stated as Bay Cities Transportation Co. instead of as Bay Cities Transportation Company, which is the name of said corporation as shown in copies of its Articles of Incorporation on file with this Commission, and that this error was continued in Decision No. 62597 in which a certificate of public convenience and necessity was issued to this corporation as well as in Decision No. 63008 which denied a rehearing.

The prayer of Application No. 44305 requests the correction of this error. The Commission finds that this error should be corrected. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application therefor having been filed and based upon the above finding,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 62597 and Appendices A and B attached thereto are amended by striking therefrom the abbreviation "Co." wherever it appears and by substituting therefor the word "Company".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 62597 and Decision No. 63008 are amended so that each reference therein to Bay Cities Transportation Co. is to be construed as referring instead to Bay Cities Transportation Company.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
