O R D E R

County of Tulare is hereby authorized to construct County Avenue 95 (Terra Bella Boulevard) and County Road 256, on new alignment, at grade across a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at Ultra, Tulare County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2M-66.29. Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be substantially as shown in the application and grades of approach shall be not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by three Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).


Upon completion, the following public grade crossings shall be abolished by physical closing by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company:




Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be


extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.


