O R D E R

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct a side track at grade across Murray Street in the City of Eureka, Humboldt County, at the location and substantially as described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 5-282.9. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material as well as by two existing overhead lights, (as shown on the drawing attached to the application), one mercury vapor type (west of crossing) and one incandescent type (east of crossing). An additional 23,000 lumen mercury vapor light shall be installed on a standard to be located 30 feet easterly from the center line of the proposed side track along the southerly curb line of Murray Street. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that immediate construction of the side track is contemplated and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
