OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition, the California Dump Truck Owners Association seeks the establishment in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 of zone rates for the transportation of asphaltic concrete from Ventura County Production Area I to various Ventura County delivery zones.

According to the petition, Local Asphalt Products, a newly formed corporation, has constructed an asphaltic concrete plant within Ventura County Production Area I and expects to produce several thousand tons of asphaltic concrete products each month and ship such products by for-hire dump truck carriers. The petition states that at the present time zone rates for the transportation of rock, sand and gravel are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 from Production Area I to various Ventura County delivery zones, whereas no zone rates exist for the transportation of asphaltic concrete between the same points. Zone rates for the movement of asphaltic concrete are provided from other production areas in the vicinity of Production Area I. The petition asserts that the only rates presently available for the transportation of asphaltic concrete from Production Area I are hourly rates or mileage rates which are not suitable for the regular movements expected.

Petitioner has informed the Commission in writing that copies of the petition were mailed to various interested parties, including the California Trucking Associations, Inc. No objection to the granting of this petition has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the rates as proposed by petitioner, with certain minor adjustments to coincide with the established formula for making such rates, are reasonable, and that the resulting minimum rates will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation of asphaltic concrete in dump trucks from Ventura County Production Area I to various Ventura County delivery zones, all as described in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The petition will be granted.

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the tariff page on which the new rates would appear contains an erroneous rate for the transportation of asphaltic concrete from Ventura County Production Area E to Ventura County Delivery Zone 40A. The error will be corrected.


IT IS ORDERED that:


2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
