OPINION AND ORDER

J. Fink Beckman and Louise M. Beckman, doing business as Otto F. Beckman, are authorized to operate as a public utility u warehouseman in Lodi and Lockeford. By this application, they seek to have their operative right revoked and their tariff canceled.

According to the application, applicants specialize in the storage of sacked grain and beans. They assert that warehouse service has not been provided to anyone for the past three years for the reason that grain and bean growers and dealers in the vicinity of applicants' business have discontinued the storage of said products in sacks and applicants have no bulk storage facilities.

Upon consideration of the allegations contained in the application, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed discontinuance and abandonment of the public utility warehouse operation as sought herein will not be adverse to the public interest. Applicants will be authorized to discontinue said operations and their tariff will be canceled. A public hearing is not necessary.

The warehouse operative right was determined by order of the Com-. mission, dated September 1, 1960, in Case No. 6941.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. J. Fink Beckman and Louise M. Beckman, doing business as Otto F. Beckman, are hereby authorized to discontinue operations as a public utility warehouseman at Lodi and Lockeford and the prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by J. Fink Beckman and Louise M. Beckman as determined by order dated September 1, 1960, in Case No. 6941, is hereby revoked.

2. Warehouse Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2, of Otto F. Beckman is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
