OPINION AND ORDER

This matter relates to the zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 that apply for the for-hire carriage of rock, sand and decomposed granite by dump truck equipment from defined production areas to designated delivery zones within the portion of Los Angeles County that lies generally to the south of the San Gabriel Mountains. The California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., petitioner herein, seeks the extension of the zone system of rates, so that said rates may be assessed by for-hire carriers for the movement of rock products from facilities of Processed Materials Co. at Chatsworth and San Fernando.

Petitioner alleges and states that Processed Materials Co. is a producer of decomposed granite, rock and sand base materials; that the company has recently established plants at San Fernando and Chatsworth for the production of these materials; that it expects to ship in excess of a million tons of rock products from each plant; that the distance rates and hourly rates which may be assessed under

present provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 do not provide appropriate bases of charges for the transportation involved; that zone rates apply for like transportation from plants of competing rock products producers in the same general area; and that the extension of the zone rates as sought is necessary in order to avoid rate discrimination against the shipments of Processed Materials Co.

In the petition are set forth sketches and territorial descriptions of the additional production areas that petitioner seeks to have established in connection with extension of the zone rates, and time and mileage data necessary for the computation of rates from the proposed production areas corresponding to the present zone rates for the transportation of rock products within the aforesaid portion of Los Angeles County. Also are set forth the specific rates which petitioner seeks.

The California Trucking Associations, Inc., has been informed of petitioner's requests in this matter, and has not indicated opposition thereto. ✓✓

It is evident from the facts recited in the petition that extension of the zone system of rates to apply to the transportation of rock products from the Chatsworth and San Fernando plants of Processed Materials Co. would do no more than provide for said transportation rates of the same kind and character as those that apply for like transportation in the same general area. It is evident also that the specific changes which petitioner seeks to have made in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 are intended to accomplish this result. Nevertheless, it appears that before being adopted, the proposed tariff provisions should be modified for purposes of clarity and to eliminate the effect of certain errors in calculation of the rates

to apply. Subject to such modifications, the Commission finds and concludes that the proposed revisions will result in just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges. To this extent the petition will be granted.




IT IS ORDERED that:

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.




