FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 63418, dated March 20, 1962, the Commission, among other things, authorized J. Christenson Co., a corporation, to transfer operative rights and properties to California Motor Transport Co., a corporation. The Order became effective April 9, 1962.

Ordering Paragraph 4 required thirty days' notice be given of the adoption of the existing tariffs by California Motor Transport Co., a corporation. Applicants report that the transaction required approval by the Interstate Commerce Commission, which they have now obtained, and that they desire to make the transfer as soon as possible. Accordingly, applicants request that the Commission's Order be amended

by providing for five days' notice. The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion, and so finds and concludes, that an amendment to said Order to provide for ten days' notice is not adverse to the public interest, therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Order in Decision No. 63418, dated March 20, 1962, be, and it hereby is, amended so as to provide for ten days' notice of adoption of tariffs by California Motor Transport Co., a corporation, instead of thirty days' notice.

This First Supplemental Order is effective on the date hereof.
