SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 63548 provided in Ordering Paragraph 3 thereof that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted should not be effective until applicant, in a manner acceptable to the Commission, should (1) submit plans for increasing the filtering and storage capacities of its system; (2) submit plans for providing an adequate three-day supply during periods of interruptions of service of the Tuolumne Main Canal; (3) execute a contract or agreement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company for an amount of water sufficient to meet the requirements of the certificated area.

It appearing that these conditions have been met by applicant,

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 63548 is effective the date hereof.
