ORDER

City of Rocklin is hereby authorized to construct Sunset Boulevard at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Rocklin, Placer County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A), as amended, attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-109.9-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

Applicant has advised that a large real estate development is dependent on early construction of Crossing No. A-109.9-A and has requested immediate authorization. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
