In the Matter of the Application of JESS HERRING and GEORGE A. DICKEY, doing business as Eureka Jitney Company, for authority to discontinue service on its route No. 5, 5A, 5B.

OPINION

Jess Herring and George A. Dickey, doing business as Eureka Jitney Company and presently rendering a passenger stage service in the City of Eureka and vicinity, request authority to abandon their Routes No. 5A and 5B. Authority to operate over said routes was granted by Decision No. 63437 dated March 20, 1962, in Application No. 44167.

It is alleged that applicants extended their service over the above routes at the requests of many residents; that after 30 days the daily passenger revenue averaged less than \$10 for 180 vehicle miles; that Routes No. 5A and No. 5B are a financial burden upon the balance of applicants' operations and that much of the area served by said routes will continue to be served by Route No. 4, which duplicates the other routes at distances ranging from 0.2 of a mile to 0.5 of a mile.

Copies of the application were served upon the City of Eureka and the Board of Supervisors of Humboldt County. No protest has been received.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicants'

service over Routes No. 5A and No. 5B. A public hearing does not appear necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. After the effective date hereof, Jess Herring and George A. Dickey may discontinue passenger stage service over Routes No. 5A and No. 5B.
- 2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall amend their tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.
- 3. Appendix A of Decision No. 62728 is hereby amended by substituting Second Revised Page 2 attached hereto in place of First Revised Page 2.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
