ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHT

California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., a corporation, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of new and used, crated and uncrated, household, office, store and institutional furniture and fixtures, household goods, pianos, musical instruments, trunks, baggage and personal effects (when tendered in a mixed shipment with household goods) between San Diego and Los Angeles and intermediate points.¹

The Commission received a copy of a cancellation notice dated January 18, 1962, addressed to California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., whereby Western Classification Committee, Agent, notified it that its participation in Western Classification 77 would be canceled effective April 30, 1962.

Subsequently, by letter from the Secretary of the Commission, California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., was placed on notice that its highway common carrier operative right would be subject to suspension or revocation, pursuant to lawful procedures, should it fail to maintain a classification in effect. The publishing agent filed with this Commission a tariff revision eliminating

Decision No. 63371 dated March 6, 1962, in Application No. 43995, authorizes California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., to sell and transfer, and Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., to purchase and acquire this highway common carrier operative right on or before July 1, 1962.

California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., as a participating carrier in the aforementioned classification effective April 30, 1962. The above carrier has not filed a classification to replace the canceled classification. Also, Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., does not have a classification on file with this Commission.

Section 486 of the Public Utilities Code requires that common carriers of property file with this Commission schedules showing their rates and classifications. Section 493 of the Code provides that no common carrier shall engage or participate in the transportation of property until its schedules of rates and classifications have been filed.

The required classification not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion that such failure constitutes good cause for the suspension of the certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., by Decision No. 58409 dated May 12, 1959, as amended by Decision No. 58526 dated June 2, 1959, in Application No. 40889, or acquired by Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., by Decision No. 63371 dated March 6, 1962, in Application No. 43995, as the case may be, is hereby suspended pending further order:

2. All otherwise effective tariff filings of California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., and Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., filed as highway common carriers pursuant to the certificates involved in the decisions referred to above are hereby suspended. Suspension supplements to tariff filings so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., and Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to each of them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service or after the above mailing, as the case may be, unless before such effective date California Pool Car Distributors, Inc., or Eecht Fast Freight, Inc., shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein or shall have filed the proper and lawful freight classification as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
