O P I N I O N

The Greyhound Corporation requests the revocation of Routes No. 16.04 and No. 16.05 formerly required to serve the Los Angeles International Airport.

It is alleged that new modern facilities for the handling of air passengers have been constructed at the Los Angeles International Airport; that the new passenger terminals are located west of Alternate U.S. Highway 101, which is applicant's regular Route No. 16.01; that the former air terminals were located east of Alternate U.S. Highway 101 and Routes No. 16.04 and No. 16.05 were required to reach the access roads of the terminal area and that Routes No. 16.04 and No. 16.05 are no longer required and should, together with the special conditions attached thereto, be deleted from applicant's certificate.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service over Routes No. 16.04 and No. 16.05. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. After the effective date hereof, The Greyhound Corporation may discontinue operation over Routes No. 16.04 and No. 16.05 and the authority to operate over said routes is hereby revoked.

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetables presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

3. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 49 in revision of Original Page 49.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
